The Medicine Park Aquarium & Natural Sciences Center represents a sharply focused Phase I planned for opening in late Summer 2014 with plans for growth and expansion over a twenty-plus year period.

The aquarium will also become a major component of the Wichita's and Southwest Oklahoma's eco-tourism appeal and an additional economic driver helping to increase visitors and visitor length-of-stay in Southwest Oklahoma's Great Plains Country!
